TYPE OF ITEM: CONSENT

PURPOSE: The purpose of this item is for the Board of Trustees to approve the recommendations of the Board Policy Committee to adopt updated board policies.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In June 2024, the Board approved a global adoption of almost all of AUSD's Board Policies to align with California Education Code(s). Since then, CSBA has issued quarterly updates from December 2023 - December 2024. The Board must continue to review recommended updates and approve them through the Consent Calendar

DETAILS:

The Board Policy Committee (BPC) reviews all policy updates and presents them to the Board for final approval and adoption. The BPC met again on March 18, 2025 and reviewed mandated and quarterly updates on policies, administrative regulations, exhibits, and bylaws. The Committee is requesting the Board approve the recommendations for the updated policies listed in the attachment on the Consent Calendar. The drafts of each are also attached in the board packet.

STRATEGIC GOALS ADDRESSED:
