PURPOSE: The purpose of this item is for the Board of Trustees to approve the Independent Contractor Services Agreement with School Sport, Inc. for repair of basketball equipment at Albany High School gymnasium.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: School Sport, Inc. performs annual maintenance for the basketball equipment at the High School and Middle School gymnasiums. At their last visit to the High School, they identified equipment that would become unsafe if not repaired.

DETAILS: Repairs under this proposal include:

- Replace (2) Winches
- Add (6) mast attachments to safety straps
- Replace (1) Goal

FINANCIAL INFORMATION: Total cost for these repairs equals \$5,350 and includes all parts and labor. It will be paid from the Maintenance and Operations general fund.
