ITEM: RELEASE OF SURPLUS MATERIALS AT AQUATIC CENTER

TYPE OF ITEM: CONSENT

PURPOSE: The purpose of this item is for the Board of Trustees to approve the release of surplus materials to be disposed of by Bay Area Surplus in accordance with the existing Independent Contractor Services Agreement.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: At the May 24, 2022 Board of Education meeting, the Trustees approved a service agreement with Bay Area Surplus to dispose of surplus materials in accordance with the California Department of Education Code: Article 14: 17545. A public notice will be posted in the district and on the district website announcing the intent to dispose of surplus items. Bay City Surplus will take photos of the various items and place them on an Ebay auction site to be sold to the highest bidder. Once sold, Bay City Surplus will forward to the district the itemized proceeds from all sales, minus a percentage to Bay City Surplus, which includes fees to Ebay.

In the event of any items not selling, Bay City Surplus will inform the Director of Maintenance and Operations who is then free to dispose of the items in whatever means necessary. Every effort will be made to avoid sending the items to landfill. Bay City Surplus will provide numerous contact sources that would be available to remove the items from district sites, to prevent these items from needlessly going to the county refuse site.

DETAILS: The Albany Aquatic Center has 3 different items which are taking up space in the aquatic center. In some cases, these items have not been used for more than 4 years. See pictures below.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION: As outlined in the services agreement, AUSD will be attempting to dispose of a surplus item and will not incur any fees until the item is sold. Upon the sale of a surplus item, the District will receive a substantial percentage of the sales price.
