**ITEM: APPOINTMENTS TO THE ALBANY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE**

TYPE OF ITEM: REVIEW AND ACTION

PURPOSE: The purpose of this item is for the Board of Trustees to appoint new members to the Albany Unified School District Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Albany Unified School District established a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) for oversight of its bond measures. The purpose of the CBOC is to inform the public concerning the expenditure of bond revenues for school construction, actively review the performance and financial bond audits, and to report and advise the public as to whether the district expended the bond funds in compliance with the language and projects included in the bond measures.

The CBOC is composed of at least nine (9) members, who shall serve for a minimum of two years without compensation, and for no more than three consecutive terms. The makeup of the committee must include the following seats:

- 1 - Active member of a business organization representing the business community located within the district
- 1 - Active member in a senior citizens' organization
- 1 - Active member in a bona fide taxpayer's organization
- 1 - Parent/ guardian of a child enrolled in the district
- 1 - Parent/guardian of a child enrolled in the district and active in a parent-teacher organization, such as Parent Teacher Association or School Site Council
- 4 - "Public at large" Community member

Since this committee is governed by the Brown Act, members must be appointed by the Board and vacancies must be advertised in compliance with the Maddy Act. A special vacancy notice was posted on January 17, 2025 and applications were accepted through Monday, February 3, 2025 at 12:00pm. Three candidates from that pool of applicants were recommended and appointed by the Board at the [February 11, 2025 Board meeting](#).

A second [Special Vacancy Notice \(Maddy Act Notice\)](#) was posted on Feb. 14, 2025 for the remaining vacant seats listed below, and applications were accepted through Monday, March 3, 2025 at 12:00pm.

- 1 - Active member of a business organization representing the business community located within the district
- 1 - Active member in a senior citizens' organization
- 2 - "Public at large" Community member

DETAILS: The following candidates are recommended to be appointed by the Board based on their qualifications:

- **Ross Culverwell:** "Public at large" Community member
- **Aaron Tiedemann:** "Public at large" Community member

The next meeting for the Citizens Bond Oversight Committee is scheduled for March 19, 2025 from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm. The newly appointed members will be invited to attend once the appointments are approved.

The District will post another Vacancy Notice to receive additional applications for the remaining vacant seats:

- 1 - Active member of a business organization representing the business community located within the district
- 1 - Active member in a senior citizens' organization
