

The Albany City Charter, is hereby amended as follows (~~strikeout~~ is deletion and underline is addition):

Section 5.03 ~~PROVIDING FOR ELECTION OF OFFICERS MADE ELECTIVE BY THIS~~
~~CHARTER.~~ VOTING AGE

~~Within thirty (30) days after this Charter takes effect, the City Council shall call an election, to be held within thirty (30) days thereafter, for the election of a City Attorney, a City Judge, and a Chief of Police who shall hold office until the third Monday in April, 1930, and until their successors are elected or appointed and qualify.~~ Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Charter, persons 16 years old and above, who are otherwise eligible to vote under State law, will be considered eligible to vote in City of Albany and Albany Unified School District elections. The Council can postpone extending the franchise to sixteen and seventeen year olds past a next election on a 4/5ths vote of all members in advance of that election, so long as there have been no previous elections in which said residents have been allowed to vote.
