Enrollment Update

Enrollment is declining across the State

California TK-12 public school enrollment, dropped 2.6% from the 2019-20 to 2020-21 school year, according to the California Department of Education

It's disproportionately affecting the state's youngest students: 88% of the drop occurred in kindergarten to sixth grade.

There was undoubtedly a "pandemic effect", to this drop, but it is also due to slowing population growth and to flight out of the Bay Area due to housing costs and other factors.

AUSD enrollment has declined an average of 1.58% each year since 2014-15. The total percentage drop from 2014-15 to 2021-22 is 10.6%

High: 3881 in 2014-15

Low: 3471* projected for next year, 2021-22
