TYPE OF ITEM: **REVIEW AND ACTION**

PURPOSE: The purpose of this item is for the Governing Board to review and approve the proposed Albany High School bell schedule for 2021-2022.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND DETAILS:

The proposed Albany High School bell schedule is based on the previous in-person schedule, modified to meet the requirements of an 8:30 start time and addresses concerns with the impact of a later start. AHS's leadership teams and community feedback also encouraged an end time of no later than 4:00pm. All periods are in 5 minute increments to simplify scheduling. In order to have all lunch periods start before 1:00pm, 5th period has been moved to before lunch. A brief break was also added to Mondays between 6th and 7th periods so that students would not have more than two classes in a row without a break.
