

**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING  
SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA  
COASTAL CONSERVANCY WILDFIRE RESILIENCE PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, staff are proposing that the Coastal Conservancy allocate funding to the City for three activities: 1) development of a plan for eucalyptus tree removal and habitat restoration on Albany Hill 2) support of activities ensuring continuing fire safety on the hill, and 3) development of a natural and cultural history education and research program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the City Council authorizes staff to submit an application to the Coastal Conservancy for a Wildfire Resilience Grant in the amount of \$230,000 for the Albany Hill Eucalyptus Project (CIP No. 41015) and associated activities; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that if awarded, the City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the grant agreement and appropriates the grant funding towards the project, which will be provided to the City on a reimbursement basis for work performed.
