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**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this item is for the Board and community to provide the Governing Board and community with updated information regarding plans for summer programs.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Traditionally, the District's summer offerings have included credit recovery for juniors and seniors (English and social studies); an English learner summer bridge program; and Extended School Year for students with disabilities (as determined by their Individualized Education Plan). In the summer of 2021, the District provided a more robust TK-12 summer program to address the impact of extended school closures due to the COVID-19 global pandemic.

This past Summer School, 2022, we continued the traditional summer school programs and also added a Social-emotional Connections program (middle and elementary), a Bridge program for students in our special education program where it is not IEP mandated (middle and elementary), and expanded both the in-person credit recovery options for High School Students as well as added an online credit recovery program with in-person support available.
