WHEREAS, Albany City Council finds that the proposed speed limit change for Solano Avenue is maintenance and operation of an existing street and categorically exempt

1 from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of

3 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ORDAINS AS**

6 **SECTION 1: CHAPTER 9 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION**
7 **1.3 TITLED “DECREASE OF SPEED LIMITS ON SOLANO AND WASHINGTON**
8 **AVENUES.” IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

11 **9-1.3 Decrease of Speed Limits on Solano and Washington Avenues.**

- 12 **a.** That the maximum speed limit on Solano Avenue between Fillmore Street and
13 Cerrito Street shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour, and the maximum speed limit on
14 Washington from a point two hundred and seventy (270') feet easterly of Pierce
15 Street, being opposite the westerly property line of 818 Washington Avenue, to one
16 hundred thirty-five (135') feet westerly of Polk Street, being opposite the westerly
17 property line of 851 Washington Avenue, is hereby fixed at fifteen (15) miles per
18 hour.
- 19 **b.** That the maximum speed limit on Solano Avenue between Madison Street and
20 Tulare Avenue shall be twenty (20) miles per hour.

21 **SECTION 2: PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.**

22 This ordinance shall be posted at three public places within the City of Albany and shall
23 become effective thirty days after the date of its posting.
