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**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code section 21101 requires the City to approve by resolution the temporarily closure of any street for celebrations, parades, local special events, and other purposes when the closing is necessary for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closing; and

**WHEREAS**, use of the public right-of-way is regulated by Section 14-2 of the Albany Municipal Code. Per the Municipal Code, applications for work or use of the public right of way are processed in the form of an encroachment permit, which is subject to the approval of the Community Development Director; and

**WHEREAS**, the Albany Community Triathlon is a one day event fundraiser for the Albany Middle School and High School held since 2008.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes staff to approve for a period of three years the partial temporary street closure of Key Route Boulevard, temporary closure of Portland Avenue, Thousand Oaks Boulevard and Carmel Avenue around the Memorial Park and Albany High School block to accommodate the Albany Community Triathlon and waive the permit fees for the Albany Community Triathlon.

**BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED**, that the event organizer shall provide expanded bike parking for the event in a highly visible location.
